Here's to another year of growth, excellence, and unity!





The formal turn-over and unveiling of the San Francisco Church, marking the return of the marker to its rightful place at the San Francisco Parish after being safely housed in the UNC Museum for several decades.

Originally installed at the San Francisco Parish in

1950, the marker was later moved to the UNC Museum under unclear circumstances. Acknowledging the importance of this historical artifact, UNC reaffirmed its commitment to heritage conservation by ensuring the marker was returned to where it belongs, preserving its historical and cultural significance.
